



M3 Lost & Found Competition

Eligibility;

Entry is open to all Australian and New Zealand Modere Social Marketers/Customers who reside in Australia or New Zealand. Competition period commences 14 August 2017 until 14 February 2018.

To be eligible for entry into the M3 Lost & Found Competition all terms and conditions listed in the following categories must be complied with.

M3 Lost & Found Competition is based on the skill of enrolling into the program. Chance plays no part whatsoever in determining eligibility to receive the prize.

Entrants who purchase the M3 program for 3 consecutive months on SmartShip. If two people share an account, and both purchase M3, both people are eligible to enter.

Entrants shall submit a testimonial of 50 words or less, a photographic image of themselves and height & weight measurements at the start and the finish of the weight loss period. Images must be genuine, unaltered in any way. Modere will only accept photographs submitted electronically. Your photos should be full body shots, taken in good lighting conditions, against a neutral backdrop. The resolution of your photos must be no less than 300dpi and of a size no less than 420 x 294 pixels.

Entrants must use the M3 Program products and cannot use similar or competitive products from any other company during the competition period.

Notification;
